The program was formed in 2007 to help prepare local boys with the skills essential to compete at Shorewood HS. All boys from Einstein Jr. High and all 5th & 6th grade boys from Echo Lake, Highland Terrace, Meridian Park, Parkwood and Syre are invited to try out for Thunderbird Select Hoops teams. There will be one team of ten boys formed in each of the four grade levels from 5th-8th grades, and each team will represent Shorewood HS in the 19-team WESCO Youth Basketball League. Practices begin in October, and league games are played from mid-December through February. This is a not-for-profit, fee-based AAU "select" basketball program intended for motivated athletes to take their game to a higher level.
