Try out for the Shorewood HS Basketball Feeder Program!

Thunderbird Select Hoops is the basketball feeder program for Shorewood High School for 5th-8th grade boys. The program was formed in 2007 to help prepare local boys with the skills essential to compete at Shorewood HS. All boys attending Einstein, Echo Lake, Highland Terrace, Meridian Park, Room Nine, Parkwood or Syre (or attend a private school but live within the SWHS boundary) are invited to try out for Thunderbird Select Hoops teams. There will be one team of 9-12 boys formed in each of the four grade levels from 5th-8th grades, and each team will represent Shorewood HS in the 18-team WESCO Youth Basketball League. Practices begin in October, and league games are played on Saturdays from early-December through February. This is a not-for-profit, fee-based AAU "select" basketball program intended for motivated athletes to take their game to a higher level. Check out our website for more information.
